45th 'Nightjar' Navigational Rally – (Virtual) Saturday 21st November 2020 REGULATIONS AND ENTRY FORM

The NHAEG, on behalf of the Austin Ten Drivers Club, will stage a virtual 'Nightjar' Navigational Rally on the 21st November 2020. This will form part of the Inter Register Club Championship series 2020 and will be held under these regulations and such others as may subsequently be issued prior to the event.

A maximum of 40 entries will be accepted from members of all affiliated IRC member clubs, plus the VSCC and other invited clubs and individuals.

For those familiar with the usual 'Nightjar' format, seeking hidden bird signs, this year, will not feature highly. Instead, entrants will carry out six navigational exercises, which, when accurately executed, should lead them to a small village somewhere deep in the Herefordshire countryside where, using Google Earth (Streetview), observational powers will be needed to answer a number of questions. Since no physical driving or other activity is required time permitted to complete the event is less than would normally be allowed, but is deemed to be sufficient to do so, although complete beginners, i.e. those who have never competed previously in such an event, either actual or virtual, are being allowed more time.

8.00 p.m. (Beginners)

Entry classes: **EN** Experts and Novices

N.B. An Expert is one who has been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an

IRC or VSCC rally within the past three years.

A Novice is one who has entered an IRC or VSCC rally within the past three years but who has **NOT** been placed First,

Second or Third.

B Beginners

A Beginner is someone who **is** a **total** beginner. who has **never**

entered such an event before, actual or virtual.

Edition revised 2011, re-printed February 2016 was used to set

navigational exercises; earlier editions may be suitable.

Instructions and questions will be emailed out to all at **5.00 p.m**. There will then be **2.5** hours for EN Entries to complete the event and **3** hours for B entries. All result sheets should be returned to the organiser by the time indicated above.
