SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1 The M.G. Car Club Ltd - South East Centre will organise a Navigational Scatter Rally Taster Event on 1st October 2023. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations. The Motorsport UK permit has been applied for and route liaison work carried out.
- 2 **All entrants, including drivers and navigators, are now required by Motorsport UK to hold a RS Clubman's Licence** obtainable free of charge from <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/>, or by post using the application form. In the event that entrants have not obtained a RS Clubman's Licence, they can complete an application form on the day and hand in to the organisers before the event (if 'YES' is entered to either of the application form medical questions, you can only enter as a passenger/navigator on the day). Minimum age for navigators is 12 and passengers 2 years old.
- 3 The event will be run using the 1:50,000 series Ordnance Survey map, Landranger Ordnance Survey Map 187, Dorking & Reigate. A recent version of this map (2013 edition), plus a writing implement for marking points on the map and filling in answers to the questions, will be the minimum that is required. Coloured stickers (or other useful devices) for marking are up to the individual teams. A Romer, for measuring grid references on the map, is available free of charge at the start.
- 4 The event will start at the Inn on the Green, Ockley, RH5 5TD. Signing in will take place from 10:15am with a briefing and Final Instructions being given at 10.55am, and any competitor not signed on by then may be deemed a non-starter. The event will start at 11.00am and finish at 2:30pm at same public house. The maximum mileage for the event is estimated as 90.
- 5 Participants will be required to visit a selection of locations defined by map references, and at each place will need to answer a question related thereto. The list of locations will be handed out at 11.00am. Participants will **not** be required to visit all locations, and only the 20 best answers will count towards the final score, Points will be awarded ranging from 1 point (visible from the car) to 2 and 3 points which will need to be located on foot at a suitable off-road parking location
- 6 Classes will be as follows:
 - A Pre-1955 cars
 - B All MGs
 - C MGs from 1955-1995
 - D MGs from 1995 on
 - E Non-MGs.The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.
- 7 Awards will be as follows:
 - First MG
 - First in class (*subject to 4 entries in class*).
 - Second in class (*subject to 6 entries in class*).
 - Novice awardRosettes and IRC prizes will be given out on the day. The full awards for MG entrants will be given out at the Annual Club Awards event
- 8 All entries need to be made pre-event. The entry fee is £12 per car for MGCC/Motorsport UK affiliated clubs or £15 per car for non-affiliated club members and should be submitted with the Entry Form to the Secretary of the Meeting.. Entry fees should preferably be paid by electronic payment (see details below), but if this is not possible cheques can be sent to the secretary of the meeting with the entry form. Once

the Entry Form, and the entry fees have been received by the organisers, the entrant will be given an entry number and sent the pub lunch menu; the food choices need to be sent to the organiser by 27th September, as the pub wants the food details the week before the event

- 10 The maximum number of entrants is 36 and the minimum is 10.

- 11 Entry fee payments should be made with the completed entry form or by bank transfer.

- 12 Global Positioning Systems are not allowed. The penalty for use is disqualification. Entrants with a three-adult occupancy in the car will incur a 10% penalty on the final score, whilst four adults will incur a 15% penalty.

- 13 The event is untimed, other than having an overall time period for completion. Competitors must at all times full comply with the Road Traffic Act/Highway Code whilst driving on the highway.

- 14 Drivers should ensure that their car insurance will cover this event as technically it is a Motorsport UK classified Rally event. No insurance company has so far refused to insure for this type of event on normal car insurance because it is on public roads with no element of timing or speed and entrants must comply with the Road Traffic Act and Highway Code apply at all times.

- 15 Entrants can be members of the MGCC, a Motorsport UK affiliated Clubs or members of non-affiliated Motorsport UK clubs. Members of the public can enter the event by agreement with the Secretary of the Meeting. Typically, Motorsport UK affiliated clubs will be a member Clubs of the Association of South East Motor Clubs. The Inter Register Club is also invited to participate in this event.

- 16 As a "Taster" event, any non-MGCC or Motorsport UK Affiliated Clubs entrants for this event will be considered to be members of the MGCC for the event by completing the event entry form, and will thereby agree to comply with MGCC Rules and Procedures.
