



M.G. Car Club Ltd - South East Centre Autumn Naviscat (Taster Event) 22nd March 2026

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1 Announcement

The M.G. Car Club Ltd - South East Centre will organise a Navigational Scatter Rally Taster Event on 22nd March 2026

2 Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.

3 Permits

The ASN permit has been applied for and route liaison work carried out with the Sussex RLO.

4 Eligibility

The event is open to Members of the MGCC, members of Clubs affiliated to Motorsport UK, and because of the Taster Event classification, members of the public.

Entrants can be members of the MGCC, a Motorsport UK affiliated Clubs or members of non-affiliated Motorsport UK clubs. Members of the public can enter the event by agreement with the Secretary of the Meeting. Typically, Motorsport UK affiliated clubs will be a member Clubs of the Association of South East Motor Clubs. The Inter Register Club is also invited to participate in this event.

As a "Taster" event, any non-MGCC or Motorsport UK Affiliated Clubs entrants for this event will be considered to be members of the MGCC for the event by completing the event entry form and will thereby agree to comply with MGCC Rules and Procedures.

All entrants, including drivers and navigators, are now required by Motorsport UK to hold a RS Clubman's Licence obtainable free of charge from <https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org/>, or by post using the application form. In the event that entrants have not obtained a RS Clubman's Licence, they can complete an application form via Smart phone (if 'YES' is entered to either of the application form medical questions, you can only enter as a passenger/navigator on the day). Minimum age for navigators is 12 and passengers 2 years old.

Drivers should ensure that their car insurance will cover this event as technically it is a Motorsport UK classified Rally event. No insurance company has so far refused to insure for this type of event on normal car insurance because it is on public roads with no element of timing or speed and entrants must comply with the Road Traffic Act and Highway Code apply at all times.

7 Event Start

The event will start from The Jolly Tanners pub, Staplefield at OS 198 Brighton & Lewes map ref 274284. Signing in will take place between 10.30 am and 11.00 am and any competitor not signed in by then may be deemed a non-starter. The event will start at 11.15 am and finish by 2.30pm at the start location. The maximum mileage for the event is estimated as 80.

8 Description of Event

Participants will be required to visit a selection of locations defined by map references and at each place will need to answer a question related thereto. The list of locations will be handed out at 11.15 am. Participants will not be required to visit all locations and only the best 25 answers will count towards their final score, i.e. no more than 75% of the total number of locations. The majority of points will not be visible from the car.

The event will be run using the 1:50000 series **Ordnance Survey map, Landranger sheet 198 Brighton and Lewes**. A recent version of this map, plus a writing implement for marking points on the map and filling in answers to the questions, will be the minimum that is required. Coloured stickers or other useful devices) for marking are up to individual teams. A romer, for measuring grid references on the map, is available free of charge at the start.

The event is untimed, other than having an overall time period for completion, although a one point penalty will accrue for every minute after the finish deadline at 2.30pm. Competitors must at all times full comply with the Road Traffic Act/Highway Code whilst driving on the highway.

Global Positioning Systems are not allowed. The penalty for use is disqualification. Entrants with a three-adult occupancy in the car will incur a 10% penalty on the final score, whilst four adults will incur a 15% penalty.

Classes will be as follows:

- A Pre-1955 cars
- B All MGBs
- C MGs from 1955-1995
- D MGs from 1995 on
- E Non-MGs.

The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.
